The Chauncy Junior Enrichment Summer School is an initiative aimed at Ware and surrounding villages junior school students in **Reception** to **Year Six** .

For those students who break up from their primary schools on Friday 17th July, the Summer School has a chargeable rate per child of £50 per week (Mon to Fri) or £100 per fortnight.

For those students who break up on Tuesday 21st July there is a rate of £30 for the three remaining days (Wed to Fri) or £80 per fortnight. This works out at an incredible **£2.30 per hour** of high quality, educational summer fun!

The Summer School is sponsored by The Chauncy School, Ware and Villages Extended Schools Consortia and the East Herts Council Summer Activities and Playschemes Fund.

Children participating in the Summer School will enjoy a wide range of activities and experiences including sketching, collage, painting, 3D design, print, jewellery making, clay, digital photography and video image making. We have included some other fun activities such as Story Making, Trampolining, Multi-Sports and Dancing.

We have organised the Summer School into three sessions per day, with a morning break and lunch break dividing the sessions:

- ◆ 9.30am—9.45am **Arrival in the Hall**
- ◆ 9.45am—11.15am **Session One**
- ◆ 11.15am—11.30am **Break Time**
- ◆ 11.30am—1.00pm **Session Two**
- ◆ 1.00pm—1.30pm **Lunch Time**
- ◆ 1.30pm—3.00pm **Session Three**
- ◆ 3.00pm—3.15pm **Collection from Hall**

We will organise the children into activity groups so that they can experience every session that we are running. Group sizes and ages will depend on the age and number of children who apply for the Summer School but a likely model may be:

- ◆ **Group One: Reception and Year One**
- ◆ **Group Two: Year Two and Year Three**
- ◆ **Group Three: Year Four**
- ◆ **Group Four: Year Five**
- ◆ **Group Five: Year Six**

Children will need to bring a packed lunch, a snack and a water bottle, some clothes that you won't mind getting dirty or paint on them and a water-proof jacket for working outside.

The number of places on this Summer School is limited to **200 children** so places will be offered on a first come first served basis.
