The Chauncy Arts Easter School is an initiative aimed at Ware and Villages primary school students in Reception, Year One, Two, Three, Four, Five and Six.

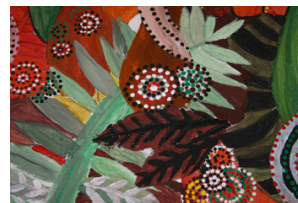

# Chauncy Easter School Activities

## Creative Art with Mr Grant

Students will research famous landmarks and using a variety of techniques, will create their own designs inspired by structures such as the Eiffel Tower, the Pyramids, Sydney Opera House, the Houses of Parliament and the statue of Liberty.



## Superheroes with Mrs Cox

Create your own superhero character, write their adventures and design their costume! A range of creative activities that will improve literacy skills in a fun and exciting way!



## Claymation with Mr Suleyman and Mr Crawley

Students will create animated movies using stop animation techniques and clay to create characters and scenes. Students will work together in groups to produce a short film.



## Creative Culture Carnival with Mrs Hammond

Students will take part in a number of activities finding out about carnivals, creating masks, experimenting with 'bin bag' fashion to create carnival outfits and even designing their own costume in a fashion design style.



## Multi-Sports with Miss Goodwin, Miss Green and Mr Steventon

Students will enjoy a range of activities from tennis to rounders and experience new sports such as Lacrosse!

## Miss Goodwin, Miss Green and Mr Steventon

Students will be given an introduction to trampolining which will develop their skills and build self confidence.

## Fun Science with Mrs Zaver

'Fun Science' Club will explore and investigate the world around you. If you are a budding scientist this is the place to be. If you are not ... you will be!

## Model Making with Mrs Silver and Miss Cheshire

Students will participate in model making by taking part in a range of activities including paper mache and clay.

Students will participate in each activity on a carousel basis. Classes will be taught in mixed age groups with differentiated tasks. There will be five activity sessions per day, three short breaks and a longer lunch break.
