**FRENCH EXCHANGE Host Families Needed:
WEDNESDAY 21 MARCH to WEDNESDAY 28 MARCH 2012**

The first part of the exchange took place in November 2011. Twenty of our students from years 8 to 11 are participating, but there are more students in the class from France who will need a host family in March. Currently, I am looking for 4 more families to participate as at present one girl and three boys have no where to stay.

This would be an excellent opportunity for some Chauncy students to become involved in the exchange programme. The commitment is to welcome the French student into your home for the week, bring them to school each day to catch their coach with a packed lunch and meet them again at the end of the day. They then spend the evenings and weekend with your family. The cost is simply that of one extra person in the house for the week and excursions of your choice at the weekend. It is a good introduction for your son/daughter to participate in a future exchange.

Your son/daughter would be included fully in the programme of activities for the week:

JOINT DAY OUT: I very much hope your son/daughter would be able to join us on our joint day out in London, including a flight on the London Eye, a river boat cruise and We Will Rock You at a cost of £42.00, which includes coach travel for the day. Payment can be made by cash, cheque or via Wisepay and should be made by 28th February 2012.

END OF EXCHANGE PARTY: You are also warmly invited as a family to come to the Party on the last night.

MEETING: Finally, we would like to invite you to meeting about this second part of the exchange on Wednesday 22 February at 5 .30pm where you will be able to meet the other families.

If you would like to take part in this, the second part of the exchange, please complete the reply slip and personal detail form and return it to me personally by FRIDAY 27 JANUARY with a passport sized photo attached. I will then telephone you once we have matched up the students.
