PGL WEEKEND NETBALL TOURNAMENT, TORQUAY 27-29TH APRIL 2012

I have provisionally booked 64 places for members of the school netball teams to take part in a weekend of netball tournaments run by the PGL tour company. This will take place from **27-29 April 2012** at Barton Hall, Torquay - one of PGL's premier centres.

We will travel by coach on **Friday 27 April, departing Chauncy at 9.30 am**. Matches will be organised all day on Saturday 28th April and on Sunday morning 29th April. There will also be a range of adventure activities available on Saturday with organised evening entertainment on both Friday and Saturday evenings. All rooms are en-suite and there will be full-board accommodation from evening meal on Friday to lunch on Sunday. We will travel home by coach after lunch on **Sunday 29th April 2012, arriving back at Chauncy at approximately 8.30 pm**-depending upon traffic.

The full cost of this visit including return coach travel and accommodation will be **£125.00**. To secure a place on this trip an initial non-refundable deposit of **£50.00** is required and this must be paid by **Monday 31 October 2011**. The balance of **£75.00** which can be paid in instalments must be made by **Friday 6 January 2012**.
